On Friday, November 12th, the Costa Mesa Police Department will be opening access to a new link on the Police Department’s website. Developed by the Crimes Against Persons - Unsolved Case Team, this link will provide information about unsolved homicides, unsolved violent crimes, wanted suspects, and missing persons. The personnel assigned to this team continually review and update case information on “Cold Cases” spanning 40 years, seeking new information and potential leads. By making information on these cases more accessible to the public, it is hoped that new or additional leads might be generated.

“These victims and their families are not forgotten by us, and there are undoubtedly persons that may have information on many of the cases to be profiled. These victims were neighbors, friends and co-workers of persons that may still reside or work in our community. This website link greatly expands our reach to those that have moved away from the area and who, upon seeing the information in the case profiles, may recall information not previously known or reported,” said Lt. Paul Dondero of the Costa Mesa Police Department’s Detective Bureau.

The website link includes telephone contact information for the Costa Mesa Police Department Detective Bureau, detectives assigned to the Unsolved Case Team, and a link for those that may choose to correspond by way of email. Bulletins and information posted on the website link will be continually updated as necessary, and additional new bulletins posted as they are developed, many in both English and Spanish.
